You need:

2 sheet steel angle for the left and the right side of your elektron machine

2 M3x6 mm screws to fix the angles to your elektron machine

2 hollow aluminium bars in the size of the width of an elektron machine stability

2 screws that fit in the aluminum bar and to screw the bars between the two angles for stability
